> This [peace, righteousness, security, and triumph over opposition] is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and this is their vindication from Me," says the Lord. Isaiah 54:17

"Difficult Times Will Come"

3 ...in the last days difficult times will come. 2 For men will be arrogant, revilers...3 unloving, irreconcilable, malicious gossips...brutal...4 treacherous, reckless...avoid such men as these.

8 Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these men also oppose the truth, men of depraved mind, rejected in regard to the faith. 9 But they will not make further progress; for their folly will be obvious to all, just as Jannes's and Jambres's folly was also. (2 Timothy 3:3-9)

1. Our Church Is Being Slandered By A Few Christians

Our church has grown in it's impact in the nations so by nature so has the persecution of it. We want you to learn from us as we go. Many are bound with fear of man but you are instructed by Jesus to confront their sin against you.

Be careful, you cannot confront a sin that someone has already confessed to you. That is gossip and God's word calls that a nasty



divisive sin. If you gossip you should be called out on this too. We must forgive from the heart.

We are offering full forgiveness to those who acknowledge their sin against this body and we advise you to do the same if there are those who confess a sin that they have sinned against you.

At this time we will not mention names because we have just entered step 2 on the Matthew 18 process of reconciliation. More on that later.

Stumbling Blocks



> 7 "Woe to the world because of its stumbling blocks! For it is inevitable that stumbling blocks come; but woe to that man through whom the stumbling block comes!

8 "If your hand or your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off and throw it from you; it is better for you to enter life crippled or lame, than to have two hands or two feet and be cast into the eternal fire.

9 If your eye causes you to stumble, pluck it out and throw it from you. It is better for you to enter life with one eye, than to have two eyes and be cast into the fiery hell.

10 "See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven continually see the face of My Father who is in heaven."

Discipline and Prayer

15 "If your brother sins, go and show him his fault [m]in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother. 16 But if he does not listen



> to you, take one or two more with you, so that by the mouth of two or three witnesses every fact may be confirmed.

17 If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector. 18 Truly I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven.
