If you align yourself with the heart of your God, you can never be cancelled. If you align yourself with humans only, you can be cancelled. Especially if those humans do not know the Father.

1. Our Church Wins if You Do

The church of Jesus Christ is on this earth to teach people how to win. We stir the gifts and callings of people and encourage them to endure the process. This is our calling, to help you fulfill yours.

It is not a matter of if you will fail in this life, but when. At that point is when we must en-courage you to get up and get moving!

2. Our Gifts & Calling Are Irrevocable

Romans 11:29

29 For God's gifts and His call are irrevocable. [He never withdraws them when once they are given, and He does not change His mind about those to whom He gives His grace or to whom He sends His call.]

Peter Was Confident in His Flesh

Jesus foretold Peter that he would forsake the Christ. Peter was sure that he would not. Peter's shame almost stalled His calling.

Shame over past failures and sins can haunt and inhibit us in many ways. And Satan seeks to steal and destroy our faith by shoving our failures in our face. But Jesus intends to redeem us completely.

When Jesus chose you to be his disciple, he foresaw your future failures as sure as he foresaw Peter's. We may not want to believe that we could deny Jesus by engaging in a sin that contradicts everything we believe. But Jesus knows what is in us.



3. How David Kept His Crown

David murdered a man and seduced his wife. Why did God allow him to retain His calling, when Saul was demoted?

David acknowledged His sin and returned to God with his heart. Saul did not. Saul blamed others and sought after witches.

4. How Ministers, Politicians & Famous People Get Cancelled

People who allow carnal people to give them a title or platform can be demoted by these same people. If we allow God to raise us up, no man can set us down. Boom!

5. After You Fall, Seek the Father

Some will realize they've been dreaming the wrong dream. The chastening of the Lord is profitable. Seek God and listen to Him, not mere men who push you down.



Even righteous men sometimes wrongfully condemn us. Well meaning family members do too.

There are also those who mean great harm, who want to destroy us. These are bitter, jealous, deceived, and traumatized people. Some are just not that bright as well.
