2. Sometimes We Avoid Restoration

Titus 3:10-11

As for a person who stirs up division, after warning him once and then twice, have nothing more to do with him, knowing that such a person is warped and sinful; he is self-condemned.

3. Comfort One Another

2 Corinthians 1:3-4

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ...who comforts us in all our affliction, so that we may be able to comfort those who are in any affliction...

2 Corinthians 13:11

Speak The Same Things





1 Corinthians 1

10 Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all **speak the same thing**, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be **perfectly joined together** in the same mind and in the same judgment.

The Apostle/Pastor sets the tone for what is standardized in a church, and the lay leaders keep the culture submissive to the standard. Then, the members are to help God keep the order in the church by gently correcting division or gossip.

Every church has varying standards and protocols that we must submit to if we are to enjoy peace & prosperity in God's family.

Titus 3:10-11

Mark 9:35

And he sat down and called the twelve. And he said to them, "If anyone would be first, he must be last of all and servant of all."

7. Never Break Your Vows

Especially in marriage, we need to honor all commitments and vows.

Ecclesiastes 5:4-6

When you vow a vow to God, do not delay paying it, for he has no pleasure in fools. Pay what you vow. It is better that you should not vow than that you should vow and not pay. Let not your mouth lead you into sin, and do not say before the messenger that it was a mistake. Why should God be angry at your voice and destroy the work of your hands?

When a person joins our church, we ask that they promise to never gossip and that they will help us protect our unity. Let's make and keep this vow again in the fear of the Lord!

Romans 1:29

They were **filled with all manner of unrighteousness**, evil, covetousness, malice. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, maliciousness. **They are gossips...**
