3. The Lord Wrecks Us with Revelation of His Goodness

Isaiah 6:1-5

I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up...4 And the posts of the door were shaken...5 So I said: "Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips...for my eyes have seen the King..."

6 Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar. 7 and he touched my mouth with it, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged."

4. The Lord Wrecks Us with Revelation of His Severity

Exodus 32:9-11

9 And the Lord said to Moses, "I have seen this people, and indeed it is a stiff-necked people! 10 Now therefore, let Me alone, that My wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them. And I will make of you a great nation."



11 Then Moses pleaded with the Lord his God, and said: "Lord, why does Your wrath burn hot against Your people...

5. We Do This Safely Together

Acts 13:1-3

1 Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul.

2 As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." 3 Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away.

Note the carefulness with which the early church sought the Lord and listened to His voice. There is safety in numbers and deception cannot infiltrate us. We try the spirits together.
